Finding a topic



- As part of your final thesis (BA- or MA-thesis), you have the opportunity to work independently on a topic of your choice.
- Both empirical and theoretical work is possible.

Finding a topic

- A prerequisite for the supervision of a thesis is the selection of a suitable topic within the scope of the work focus on Organisational Behavior. In this context, your ideas and topic suggestions are always welcome.
- You can also participate in our current research projects with your own research question, which you can work on conceptually or empirically.

Supervision



- Your topic and the discussion of central steps of your work will take place during the regular consultation hours.
- The staff of the chair can also advise you on how to work on your topic, depending on your research focus.

Exposé



- The preparation of an exposé for your BA or MA thesis serves the timely and intensive examination of the conception of your thesis.
- The timely submission of an exposé is a prerequisite for the supervision of your thesis. (Submission no later than two weeks before the respective departmental registration deadlines)
- The exposé should be 3-4 pages long (BA theses) or 5-7 pages long (MA theses).
