Courses

Universität Konstanz



- individual schedule is made with online course catalogue in ZEuS
- detailed course descriptions including requirements are available there
- responsible person/lecturer can be contacted directly if additional information or literature is needed
- course registration at the beginning of the semester (October)
- necessary to have access to online learning platform Ilias
- assessments for lectures are final exams at the end of the semester (mid/end February)
- assessments for seminars are presentations/projects and term papers

Examinations





- two trials for each examination
- in exceptional cases third trial is possible upon request
- two examination periods each semester
- it is possible to take the exam only at the second date
- in case of failure it has to be revised in the next semester/year
- examination registration takes place in December/January and in early March
- is obligatory to participate in the examination to earn credits
- applies to lectures, seminars, block courses
- Important: Taking an exam without registration is not possible!
- Important: Course registration and examination registration are two separate processes!

Examinations





- if suffering from disabilities or chronic illnesses, academic adjustments are provided
- compensation for disadvantages have to be done by an application to the MSc SEDS Examination Board
- medical certificate has to be attached

Transcript of Records





- Transcript of Records can be generated by yourself via ZEuS at any time
- list of finished courses and preliminary final grade
- course registrations and failed courses do not appear on your final Transcript of Records



Final grade

Universität Konstanz



- there are courses which have to be passed but are not graded
- do not count for the final grade
- the module ,Programming and Scripting' does not count for the final grade
- module grade is the arithmetic mean of all graded performances within this module
- master's thesis and colloquium give 27 credits (24 + 3 credits) and count 25% of the final grade
- Important note: Although MSc SEDS is an interdisciplinary study programme, administration takes place in the Department of Politics and Public Administration (advisory service, formalities, deadlines)!

Specificities for SEDS

- Already very international profile
- Flexible course structure, 3rd semester most suitable to go abroad (for you: Winter Semester 2025/26)

Options:

Erasmus+ Exchange Semester / Year

- a) SEDS specific partnerships
 - Essex University: Social Data Science
 - University of Ljubljana: Social Informatics
 - University of Florence: Statistics and Data Science
- b) Partner Universities of the Departments of Politics and Public Administration, Economics and Computer Science → enrolment at the respective department at the host university

Application deadline: Feb 1st for all Departments






Erasmus conditions:

- Monthly scholarship (540€ or 600€) for 4 months per semester
- Green travel incentives
- Fewer Opportunities top ups for students from non-academic households, working students, students with disability or chronic illness









Options:


Overseas Exchange

- Institutional partnerships all over the world (North- and Latin America, Asia, Australia, New Zealand)
- Application via International Office, deadlines vary, first one: US & Canada on Nov 2
- Different scholarship options (consult the International Office)

Internships

- Funding available through the Erasmus+ program (also for non-European countries)
- Application deadline: one month before start of the internship





Options:

Regional Mobility at the University of Zurich

- Agreement between the Department of Politics and Public Administration and the Department of Political Science at UZH, possibility to take and get credit for individual courses, especially interesting modules: "Advanced Methods" and "Political Data Journalism"
- Deadlines: Mid-March for Fall Semester / Mid-September for Spring Semester
 Individual ideas (Summer Schools, Free-mover exchange, ...)
- Just approach me and we can talk about the possibilities!


