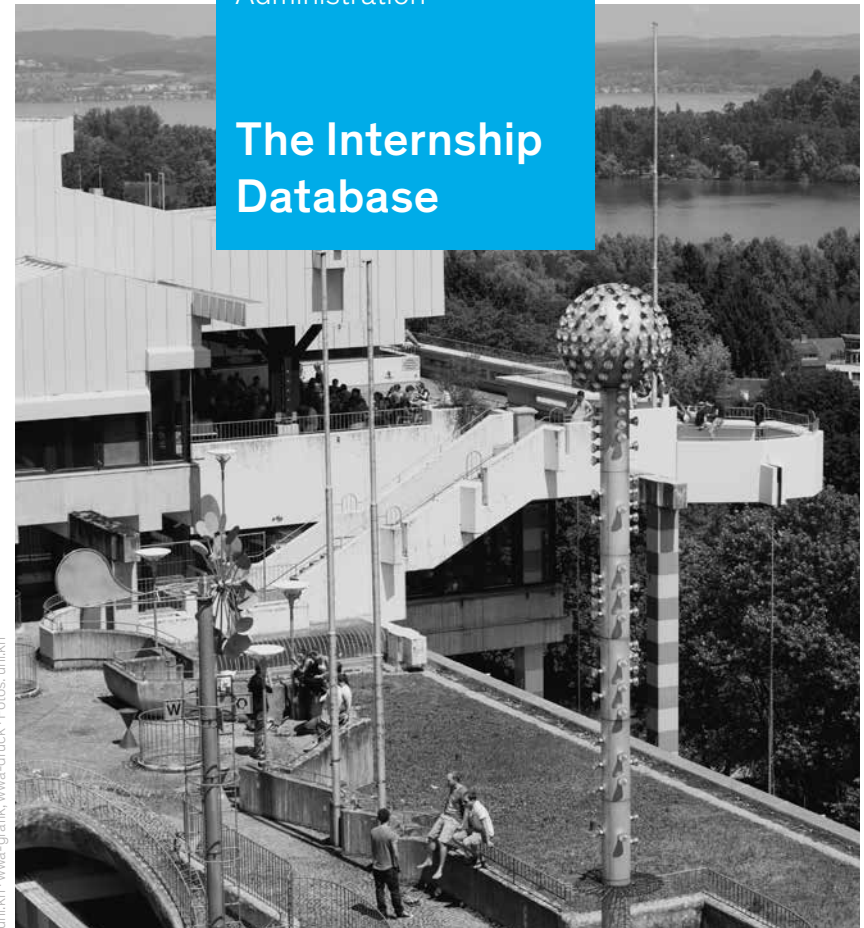

The B.A. program in Politics and Public Administration offers a unique combination of Political Science, Public Administration and Management. The program has repeatedly received top grades in the nation-wide CHE Ranking and is characterized by the following five features:

Practical Orientation

The program includes a 6-month compulsory internship period during which the students can apply their knowledge and gain professional experiences.

Focus on Research Methods

Over the course of the program, students receive a rigorous education in statistics and social science methodology.

International Orientation

The Department offers multiple opportunities to study abroad – in Europe and beyond.

Interdisciplinary Approach

Students study a broad range of subjects, ranging from courses in Politics and Public Administration to Economics and Public Law.

Research Focus

Students have the opportunity to participate in diverse research projects conducted in the Department of Politics and Public Administration.

The 6-month internship

The 6-month internship is compulsory for B.A. students and serves as a professional education module as well as an integral part of the study program with the following aims:

- to enable the students to put their theoretical knowledge into practice
- to enable the students to gain professional skills
- to provide the students with career opportunities

Therefore, the requirements for potential internship positions are very demanding. It is especially important that the students are fully integrated into the day-today business of your organization. They should work full-time and independently, either on their own or integrated into team structures. Additionally, they should be given their own areas of responsibility consisting of demanding tasks designed to expand their practical skills.
